Feed The Sox Box

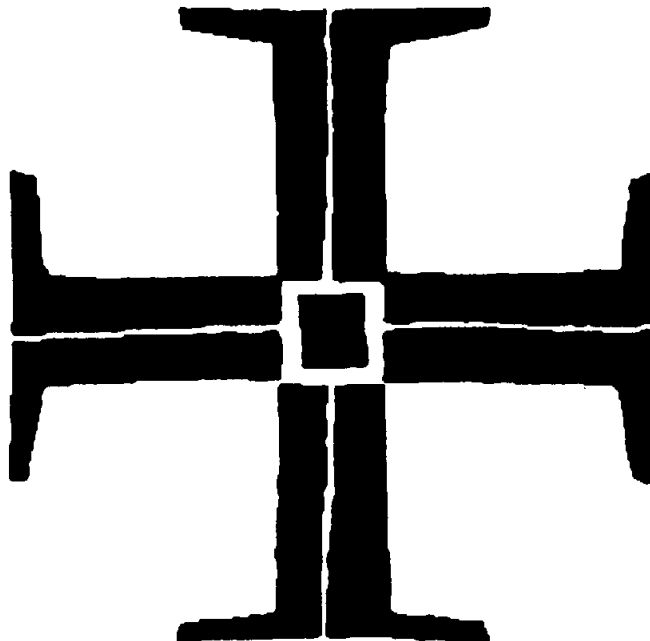
